## Order of Proceedings

1. The Installing Officer and his Assisting Officers enter in Procession under an Arch of Steel.
2. The Installing Officer will ascend his throne and appoint his Officers.
3. The Installing Officer will open a Chapter of Provincial Priory.
4. The Installing Officer will be saluted under the direction of the Great Marshal.
5. The banners of the Preceptories will be paraded and the Roll of Preceptories will be called.
6. The Installing Officer will address the Knights on the purpose of the Meeting.
7. The Great Marshal shall inform the Installing Officer that the Provincial Prior nominate, E. Kt. Frederick Richard Thomas P.Gt.St.B.(B), is in attendance and requests to be Installed.
8. The Installing Officer will direct that the Provincial Prior nominate be introduced in due form.
9. The Great Marshal will form an escort, which will retire.
10. The Provincial Prior nominate will be introduced into the Chapter Room under an Arch of Steel, preceded by the Escort bearing the Regalia on cushions.
11. The Installing Officer will demand to see the Patent of Appointment and will direct that it be read.
12. The Installing Officer will address the Provincial Prior nominate and will enquire if he is ready and willing to undertake the duties of the Office.
13. The Great Prelate will offer prayer.
14. The Provincial Prior nominate will kneel and recite his Obligation.
15. The Great Prelate will raise the Provincial Prior nominate and will conduct him to the East.
16. The Provincial Prior nominate will kneel and pay homage to the M.E. & S. Grand Master, following which he will be Invested and Installed.
17. The Great Prelate will pronounce the Benediction.
18. The Banner of the Province will be placed in the East.
19. The Right Eminent Provincial Prior shall be proclaimed from the West by the Great Herald and will be saluted under the direction of the Great Marshal.
20. The Deputy Great Marshal shall inform the Right Eminent Provincial Prior that the Provincial Sub Prior nominate, E. Kt Allan Seager P,Gt.A.-de-C is in attendance and requests to be Installed.
21. The Right Eminent Provincial Prior will direct that the Provincial Sub-Prior nominate be introduced in due form.
22. The Deputy Great Marshal will form an Escort which will retire.
23. The Provincial Sub-Prior nominate will be introduced into the Chapter Room under an Arch of Steel, preceded by the Escort bearing the Regalia on cushions.
24. The Provincial Prior will demand to see the Patent of Appointment and direct that it be read.
25. The Right Eminent Provincial Prior will address the Provincial Sub-Prior nominate and will enquire if he is ready and willing to undertake the duties of his office.
26. The Great Prelate will offer prayer.
27. The Provincial Sub-Prior nominate will kneel and recite his Obligation.
28. The Great Prelate will raise the Provincial Sub-Prior nominate and will conduct him to the East.
29. The Provincial Sub-Prior nominate will kneel and pay homage to the Right Eminent Provincial Prior following which he will be invested and conducted to his seat.
30. The Great Prelate will pronounce the Benediction.
31. The Provincial Sub-Prior will be proclaimed by the Great Herald and will be saluted by the Knights of the Province under the direction of the Deputy Great Marshal.
32. The Great Marshal will request the Right Eminent Provincial Prior to confirm the appointment of certain Provincial Officers and will replace the Officers of the Installing Team by Provincial Officers.
33. The Great Marshal will present the by-laws of the Province to the Right Eminent Provincial Prior for his approval and confirmation.
34. The Right Eminent Provincial Prior will address the Installing Officer.
35. The Templars Hymn will be sung during which alms will be collected in aid of the St. John of Jerusalem Eye Hospital.
36. The Installing Officer will retire under an Arch of Steel accompanied by the officers of the Installing Team.
37. The Right Eminent Provincial Prior will adjourn the Chapter of Provincial Priory.
38. The Right Eminent Provincial Prior will retire under an Arch of Steel.
